



## adidas Invitational 2010

### Tournament Notes

- **Check-In & Video** – Every team must check-in, confirm rosters at North Central High School and players must view NCAA video *prior* to competing in the tournament. If team has not viewed the video prior to the second game of the tournament, the team will be removed from competition. THE VIDEO IS MANDATORY VIEWING due to NCAA Rules.
- **Roster**– Each team's Roster must be confirmed at check-in, and all NCAA Regulations must be followed. Any players not fitting the adjoining state rule will be removed. Players may only participate on one team!
- **Certified Travel Coaches** – Only Certified Coaches are allowed to be on the bench for games, with a maximum of three on the bench. Any non-certified personnel need to be in the spectator/fan section.
- **Brackets** - Due to NCAA rules, only a maximum of 5 rounds may be played in two days. For this reason, some platinum division games in the 17U & 16U Divisions begin on July 6<sup>th</sup>. Also note, the 17U & 16U Platinum teams that lose their first or second round game drop to Gold and/or Palladium (17U only) divisions on July 7<sup>th</sup>. Teams in Super Pools advance to Platinum Tourneys, but are seeded based on finish. Teams in Open Pools are placed in Platinum, Silver, or Bronze tourneys based on pool finish. Super Pool teams were selected by adidas Directors.
- **Separation of College Coaches from Teams, Team Coaches, and Spectators** – Due to NCAA rules, Fans and teams must stay in designated areas. Contact with college coaches is forbidden. College coaches will also be in separate designated areas.
- **Spectators/Fans** – Fans are permitted to watch the games in designated areas upon paying admissions for each day. Admission is good for all sites for that particular day. Admissions will be \$15 on Tuesday and Wednesday, \$10 on Thursday.



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### Game Rules

National Federation high school playing rules shall be enforced, along with the following:

- **Warm-up** - consists of AT LEAST 5 minutes.
- **Games** - consist of two, 16 minute halves. Running clock with a 30 point lead last 8 minutes, or 20 point lead last 4 minutes of the 2nd half.
- **Time-outs** – two 60 second time-outs, two 30 second time-outs per game.
- **Half-time** will last 3 minutes and the clock will begin when the 1<sup>st</sup> half horn sounds.
- **One and One Bonus** – on the 7<sup>th</sup> foul of each half, 2 shot bonus on 10<sup>th</sup> foul
- **Technical Fouls** – any coach or player will be ejected from the game upon receiving 2 technical fouls. That coach or player is then suspended for the next tournament game.
- **Rosters** – Players may only be on one roster, and participate on one team only due to NCAA regulations.
- **Overtime** - shall last three minutes, in which each team will receive one 30 second time-out.
- **Pool Play Tie-Breakers** – ties will be decided by head to head competition, margin of victory among the tied teams (+ or – 15), margin of victory within the pool (+ or – 15), total points scored by team in pool, coin flip.
- **Protests** – all protests must be communicated to the Court Monitor 15 minutes after the completion of the game. Any scoring discrepancies will be settled by the official book.
- **Game Time/Forfeits** – Due to NCAA Rules, games will begin no earlier than scheduled start time. A team will forfeit the game if they are not on the assigned court within 10 minutes of game time. The forfeiting team will lose by the score of 15-0. Games cannot be held more than ten minutes due to NCAA regulations regarding final game time of night.
- **Home/Visitor** – The first team listed (top of bracket) shall be home team and wear light colored jerseys, second team listed shall be Visitor and wear dark colored jerseys.
- **Basketballs** – Warm up basketballs will be provided, and official adidas ball shall be game ball.
